

## Mental illness forecasted to be next wave of COVID-19 pandemic.

Sandri Galea, Epidemiologist and Dean of Public Health at Boston University who studied the impacts of the SARS epidemic, has reported that COVID-19 has the potential to have devastating and far-reaching effects on the mental health of the public.

In a recent statement, Lifeline reported that the number of Australians calling Lifeline in distress has risen substantially (from 23% to 39%) in response to COVID-19. This follows a previous increase of almost 15% in calls during the Australian bushfires.

Now, more than ever, do we need to be proactive in our approach to mental health with early detection and education being highlighted as crucial first steps. With item numbers for the development and/or review of a Mental Health Care Plan, Eating Disorder Management Plan, and Chronic Disease Management Plan now available via phone/video conferencing, our trusted General Practitioners have an important role to play in reducing the rates of suicide and mental illness during the pandemic.

While it remains a legislative requirement that telehealth services provided by GPs are bulk billed for Commonwealth concession card holders, children under 16 years old and patients who are more vulnerable to COVID-19, the good news is that the bulk billing incentive Medicare fees have doubled (until 30 September) and that normal billing can be applied in all other cases.
